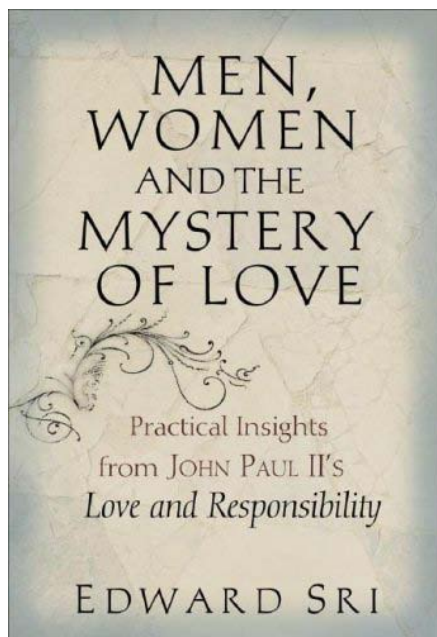




Men, Women and the Mystery of Love A Book Discussion Group
